Meet our team continued

Delia our Housing and Tenancy Officer helps people navigate Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA).

Delia supports participants and their families to explore SDA options, understand what's possible, answer questions and stay connected throughout the journey.

Delia will help by:

- Meeting with people and their family to discuss what SDA could look like for each person.
- Exploring SDA options and understanding what may best suit the person.
- Offering ongoing assistance after move-in, e.g. holding housemate meetings, and conducting maintenance and property checks to ensure safety and comfort.




